

## Pre-Kindergarten Goals

St. John's CCDC uses the Creative Curriculum to base its preschool classroom. In addition to Creative Curriculum, we also use the Growing In Christ Sunday school program as a base for our Jesus Time. The Utah State Office of Education has also published Pre-Kindergarten Guidelines which the pre-kindergarten teacher's use.

Here are some of the goals that we will hope to achieve for your child by graduation in May 2011.

- Demonstrate a positive learning attitude.
- Develop social skills and ethical responsibility.
- Demonstrate responsible emotional behaviors.
- Develop physical skills and personal hygiene.
- Understand and use basic concepts and skills.
- Communicate clearly in oral, artistic, and nonverbal forms.
- Recognize numbers 1-10.
- Recognize letters in print.
- Recognize letters in name.
- Print first name.
- Draw a person with at least five recognizable parts.
- Listen attentively and participate in conversation.
- Recognize basic colors.
- Recognize basic shapes.
- Basic addition and subtraction.
- Pre reading skills.

Each child will be formally assessed three times yearly (fall/winter/spring) in addition informal observations. Each child will have a portfolio where their teacher will track their development.
